It is chaired by the President, and its members are the Provost and Executive Vice President for Academic Affairs, the Senior Vice President for Finance and Business Services and Treasurer, the Vice President for Student Life, the Senior Vice President for University Advancement, the Vice President for Information Technology and CIO, the Vice President, and Chief Marketing & Communications Officer, the Vice President for Institutional Diversity & Inclusion, the General Counsel, the Secretary to the Board of Trustees and Executive Assistant to the President, Vice President for Enrollment Management and Student Success, the Director of Intercollegiate Athletics, the Vice Pr

University Promotion and Tenure Committee

The Committee consists of the Provost as chair, the deans (or their designees) of the six (6) academic divisions, and six tenured members of the instructional staff (one (1) from each of the academic divisions) appointed by the Provost with the President's approval. Members serve staggered three-year terms. The Committee is charged with making promotion and tenure recommendations to the Provost. These recommendations may relate to University wide promotion and tenure policies and procedures or to individuals being recommended for promotion and/or for the conferral of tenure. The Provost will appoint a representative from the Office of the Provost to serve as secretary without vote.
