Scope: Who is Covered by this Policy?

All undergraduates and prospective undergraduate students.

Policy

The Undergraduate Fresh Start Policy is designed to help Miami University undergraduate students return to good academic standing after an absence of at least two calendar years. Students who have been academically suspended or dismissed or who voluntarily left the University with a cumulative GPA below 2.00 are eligible for Fresh Start after a two-year absence.

Fresh Start status must be requested within one semester (fall or spring) of completing at least 12 graded credit hours on which a cumulative grade point average of 2.00 or higher has been earned.- The Fresh Start option applies only to courses taken before re-enrollment. The Fresh Start option cannot be applied to graduate level courses taken
